To ensure the necessary youth leadership for successful Troop operations, the Scoutmasters may modify the qualification for a position should a Scout with the minimal requirements not be available. For non-elected positions, priority may be given to scouts who need positions of leadership for rank advancement (First Class scouts and above) if there are multiple equally qualified candidates for one role.

If there are multiple unexcused absences for a Scout, the Scoutmasters may need to remove a Scout from their role of responsibility partway through their term (which could in turn have a negative impact on a Scout's rank advancement timing).
