

Youth Protection Training Instructions

Background

Scouts BSA requires all adults to take YPT (Youth Protection Training) to participate in any troop overnighters at least every two years or to be a merit badge counselor.

Troop 28 asks that all troop parents complete YPT to help the troop keep our children safe – in and out of scouting. The basic BSA program consists of three virtual modules with a running time of approx. 72 minutes.

When complete, please make sure to email your completion certificate to Troop 28's Youth Protection champion at ypt@glencoescouting.org.

Please go to http://my.scouting.org and click Create Account. Please keep track of the email you use for this account as, if your son decides to join, will ultimately be your username for all BSA accounts and there will be occasions where you will need it again.

Once logged in look on the right for the YPT training logos that look like this:

Once you are at your training dashboard, look around for the YPT program:




Please select the MANDATORY Youth Protection Training (72 minutes):



Click **Enroll** to add the program to your Learning Plan (note: this is overkill for YPT, but this system is also used to track mandatory training for Scoutmasters, and other adult leaders).



Once Enrolled you will see the listing of modules. Click on **Start** to complete each module.




Each module consists of a short series of narrated slides and videos with a few multiple choice options sprinkled in.

Tips:

You can stop and the system should retain your practice. However, if it has been awhile, it is recommended that you log out and log back in (vs. just continuing with what is on your screen) to ensure that the system hasn't timed out behind the scenes.

You can go back slide by slide, but you cannot partially rewind a video.


You will see an acknowledgement when you have completed a module. You can either click **Next** to proceed to the next module, or click on **Return To Mandatory – Youth Protection Training Details** to check your progress.



Back in your course listing, you should see that the module shows Progress at 100%.



This exam must be passed with a 75% or better passing criteria along with the other mandatory modules to receive credit for the YPT course.



After completing all three modules and passing the exam, it may take up to 24 hours to see your certificate in My.Scouting. You should receive your PDF YPT Certificate by email soon thereafter.

Please make sure to email a copy of your certificate to ypt@glencoescouting.org when you receive it. Your YPT will be valid for two years from the date you complete the course.
