Camp Oakarro and Boundless Adventures Ropes Course

- Dates:** Saturday, November 5th to Sunday, November 6th
- Location:** Camp Oakarro, Wadsworth, Illinois and Boundless Adventures, Kenosha, Wisconsin
- Adult Leaders:** Ben Miller & Linda Lin
- Departure:** St. Elisabeth's at 9:30am Saturday, November 5th. Please arrive to load gear by 9:15am.
- Return:** Pick up from Camp Oakarro at approximately 8pm for day-trippers (guests).
Pick up from St. Elisabeth's Glencoe at ~10-10:30am Sunday, Nov. 6th for campers
- Cost:** **\$35 per youth** (additional charge for parents who are interested in climbing)
- Activities:** We will make camp upon arrival Saturday morning, and prepare lunch before travelling 15 minutes to Boundless Adventure for an afternoon on their ropes courses. Pack 28 Webeles and Guests have been invited to join the outing. In the evening, the Troop will prepare a campfire and dinner & snacks for all participants as well as possibly work on rank advancement and/or night-time activities.
- At Boundless Adventures, the scouts and guests (and adults!) will be able to choose from 9 ropes courses ranging from beginner to challenging; a typical outing will include 2-5 courses. Most courses are accessible to all scouts with a supervising parent/adult on the ground. - Preparation:** Campers - Please advise if you and/or your Scout needs to check out a troop tent or borrow other troop equipment.
- All Climbers should bring a water bottle, as well as climbing gloves or other slim / fitted gloves if available, non-baggy workout apparel or long pants, and sneakers or other closed-toe shoes for the ropes courses. Sandals, flip-flops, open-toe shoes are prohibited.
- Lodging:** Overnight campers will use tents. Scouts may tent with similarly aged scouts or with a parent or sibling. You are welcome to use your own tent or a troop tent.
- Camping Gear:** Please remember to bring a water bottle & mess kit if you have one for meals. In addition, we suggest a day pack, rain gear, hiking boots or gym shoes, personal first aid kit, compass, toiletries, sleeping bag, flashlight/headlamp and spare batteries, camping chair/crazy creek, folding pocket knife, and Scout handbook.

Please wear a Class A or a Class B shirt on Saturday when we meet.
